EXALTED RULER'S MESSAGE:


Get your Elevator Speech ready!

Imagine this scenario: You are at the hospital visiting a brother or sister Elk in distress. You are standing in the lobby waiting for the elevator. You get on the elevator with another gentlemen. As you press the button for the tenth floor, you turn and ask the gentleman to what floor is he going? He responds, "Ninth floor please." He notices the Elks emblem on your shirt and asks. "What's an Elk?" You have the time it takes for

the doors to close and the elevator to travel nine floors to answer his question before he leaves and you never see him again. What do you say? Well-prepared Elks would give their "Elks Elevator Speech," - a one minute rehearsed sales pitch to "sell" a product or service. For example, I could tell my fellow elevator rider this:

"The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks is a national fraternal organization dedicated to serving the community through its charitable works. The Elks have been around since 1868. We have more than 800,000 members and nearly 2,000 Lodges nationwide. Our emphasis is on conducting youth programs, serving our veterans, drug awareness, and doing charitable work in the community in which we work and live. We also provide social opportunities for our members to enjoy food, drinks, and comradery, while raising funds to perform our good deeds. Here is my name and number, give me a call. I'll buy you dinner at our Lodge and we can talk about how you can become an Elk."

This prepared speech only takes about 38 seconds to deliver. Write your own elevator speech, or use this one! Memorize your pitch and practice it in front of a mirror until you have it down pat. So the next time you are asked, "What's an Elk?" you are prepared to sell Elkdom and help grow our Order and our Lodge. Remember, membership is the lifeblood of Elkdom!



HOOP SHOOT WINNER MEMORIAL FUND



As many of you may already know, one of our local Hoop Shoot winners, Aiden McNutt, tragically lost his life in a house fire on January 12, 2020 while visiting his mother for his birthday. Aiden had won 1st place in our 13-14 year old division of the Hoop Shoot just one day before his death. Aiden's 15-year-old sister also suffered injuries in the fire, including burns to her feet, legs, arms, and face. Both children lived

with their grandfather, Mr. Bonner, who is now working on a limited income to pay for all hospital bills for both children, as well as clothing, housing, general living expenses, and sadly, Aiden's funeral expenses. Our Lodge would like to help ease the stress and financial burdens that have unexpectedly, and tragically, been brought onto this family.
